






Cranberry Harvested WISCONSIN Acreage CRANBERRIES






Available Supply WISCONSIN vs Total Sales CRANBERRIES





Processed Sales









Fresh Fruit Sales

Cranberry Tariffs WISCONSIN CRANBERRIES

Issue is Critical for US Cranberries

EU Retaliatory tariffs – REMOVED

- HUGE IMPACT
- Duty Suspensions CRITICAL
 - SDCs for Further Processing: Renewed in December for Five Years (20%)
- UNITED KINGDOM





Dried Cranberries:

• 15% MFN + 30% Retaliatory Tariffs (Section 301 response) **Total: 45%.**

Cranberry Concentrate:

5% MFN + 12.5% Retaliatory Tariffs (Section 301 response) Total: 17.5%.
