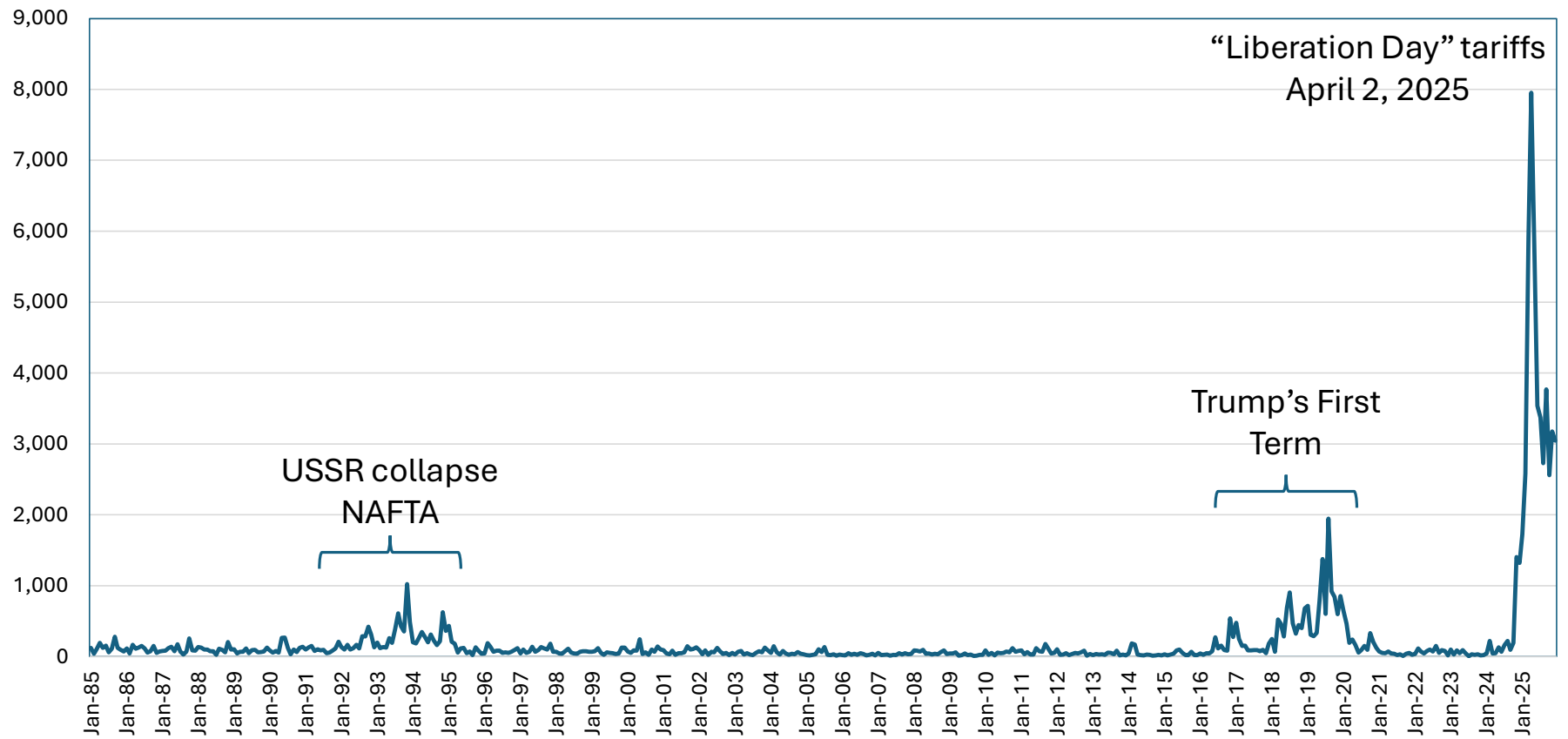

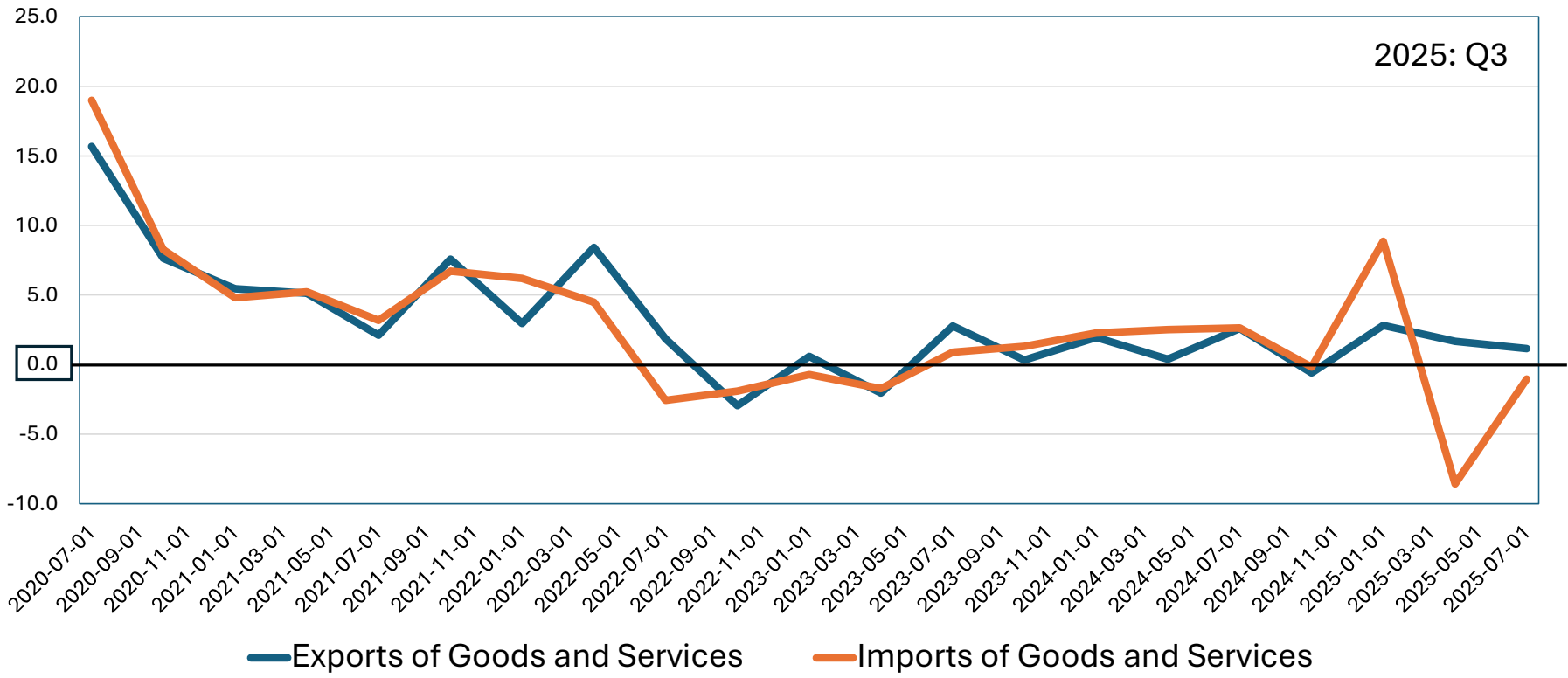
Trade Policy Uncertainty Index



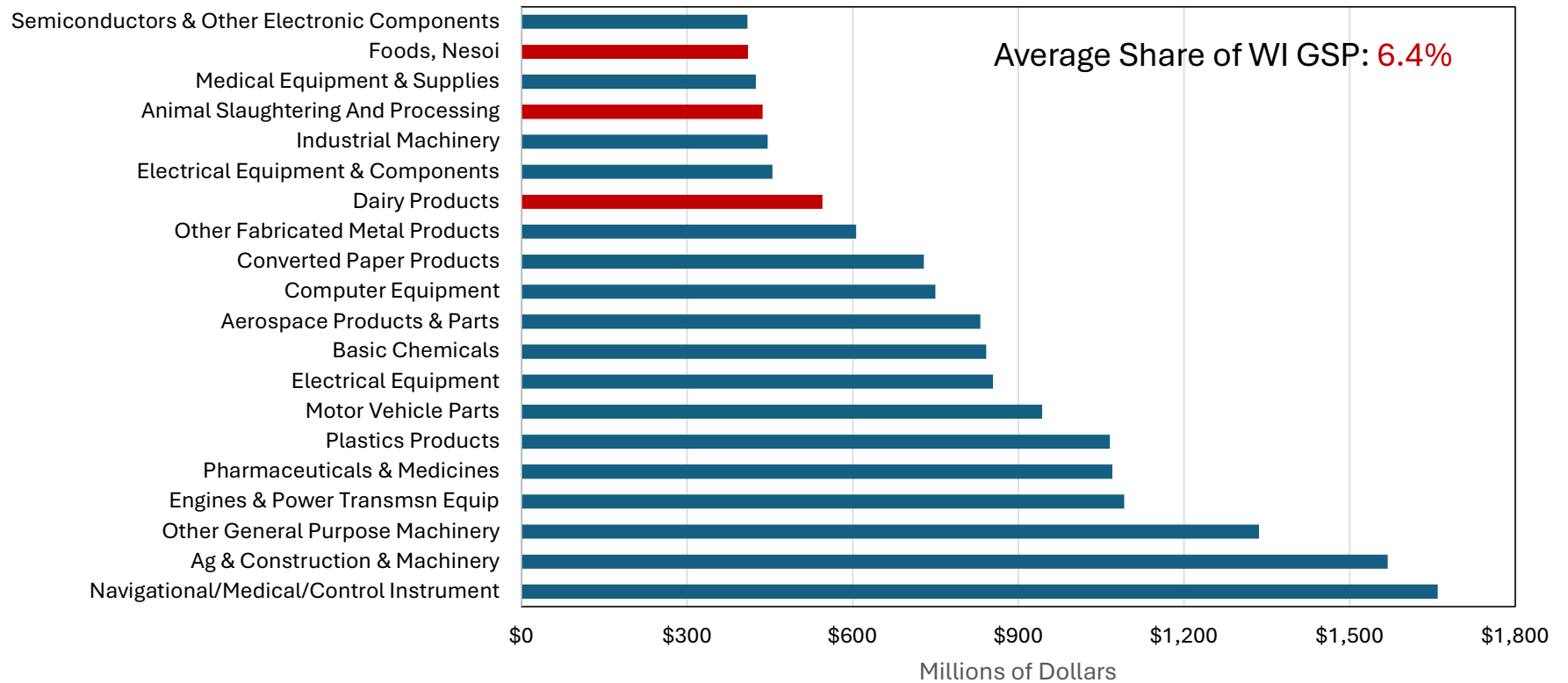


U.S. Imports-Exports

Percent Change, Quarterly, Seasonally Adjusted Annual Rate



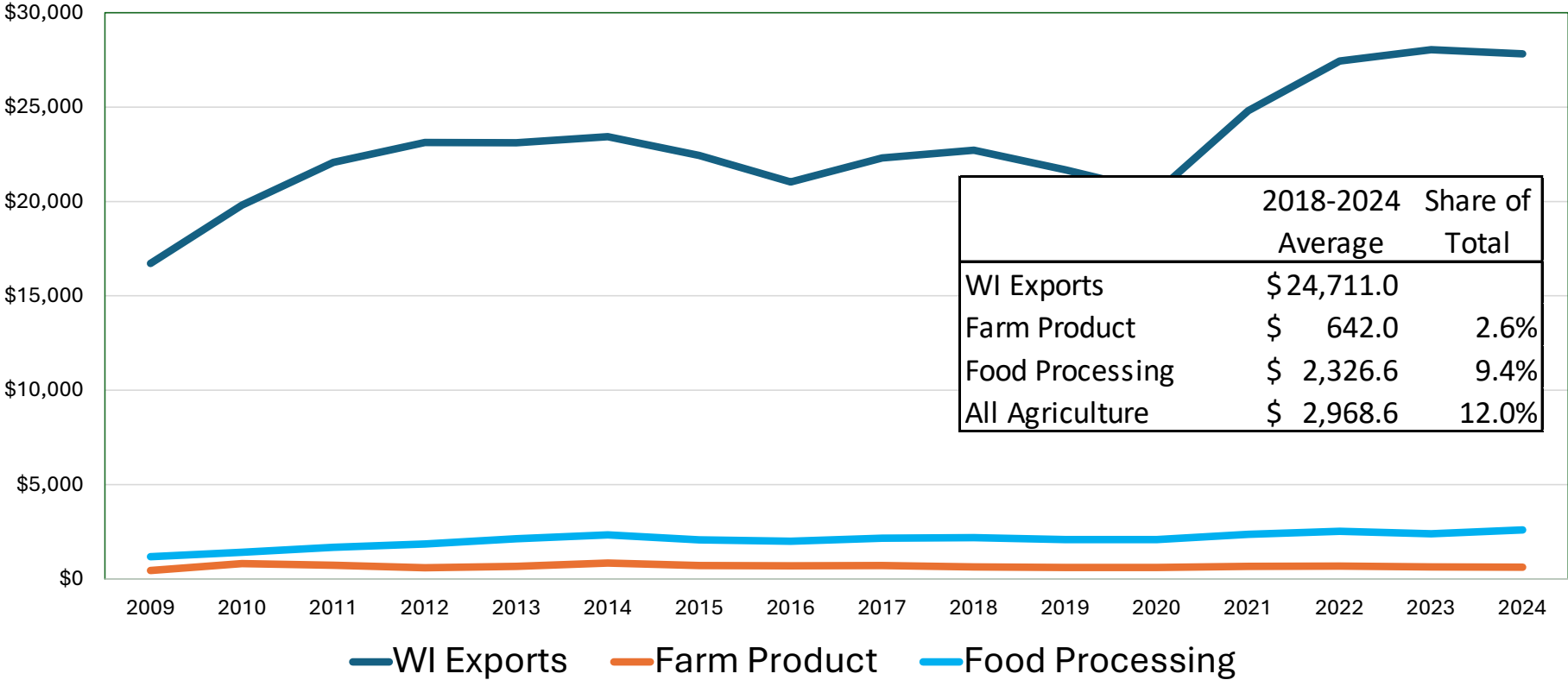
Wisconsin Top 25 Foreign Export Products (2018 – 2024 Average)

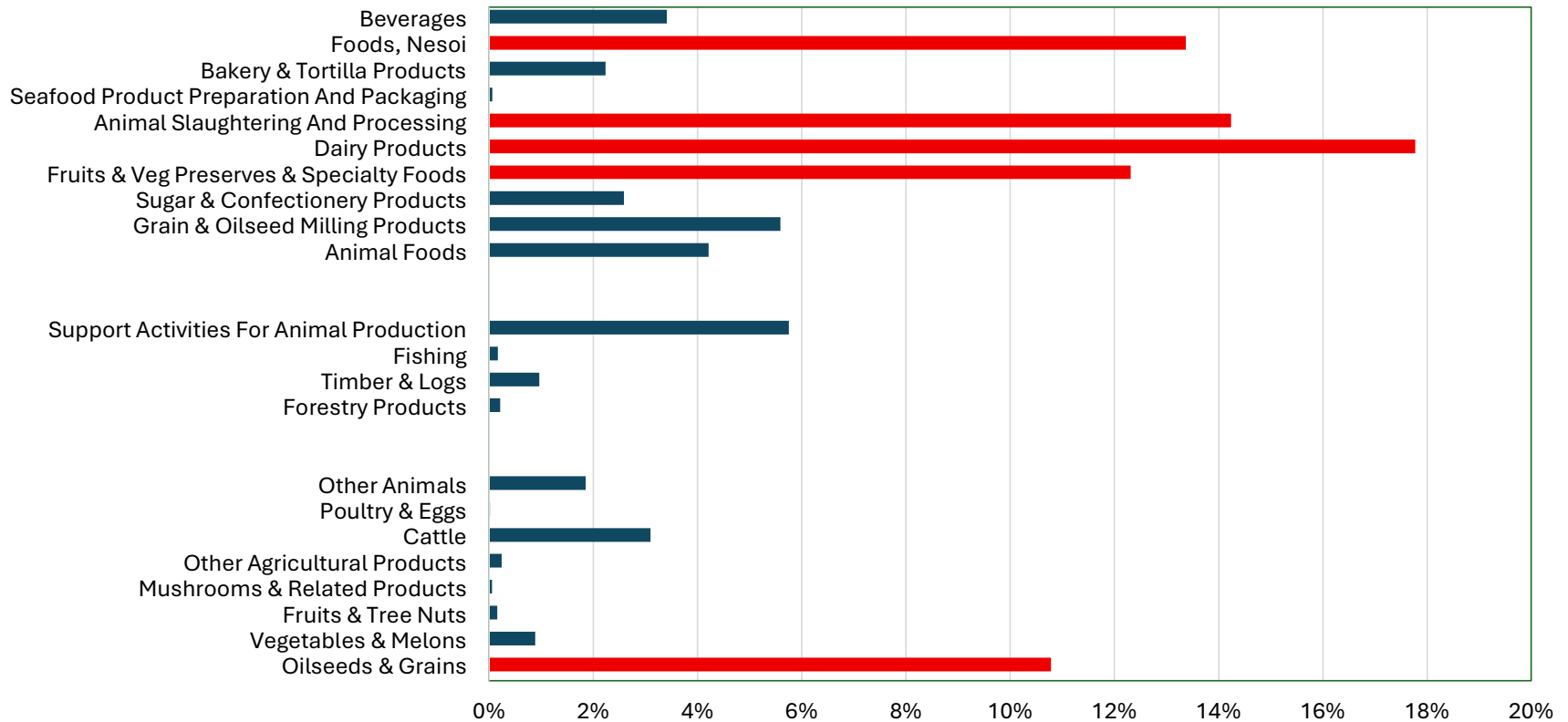


Wisconsin Foreign Exports Levels in MM\$



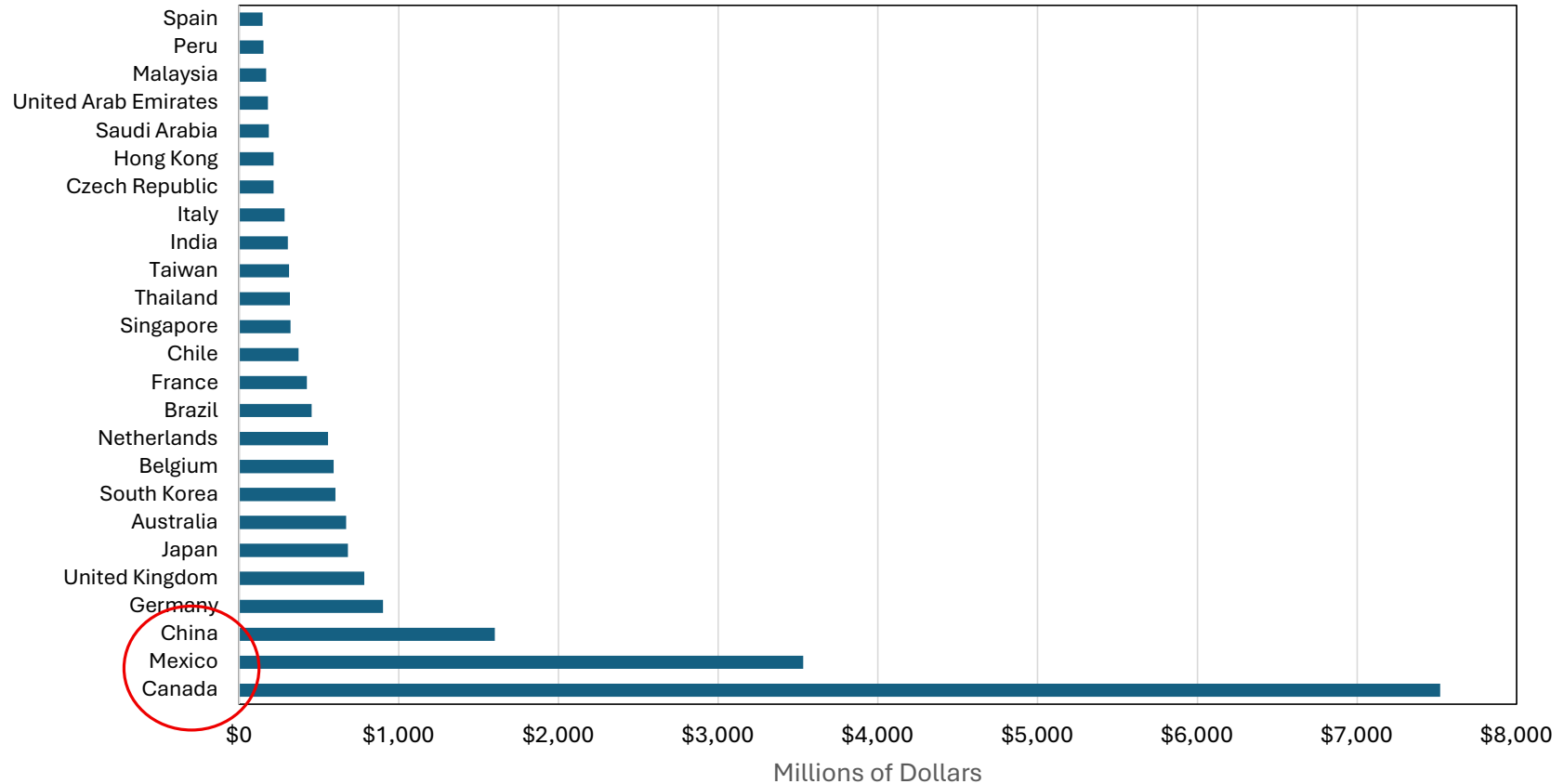

Wisconsin: Share of Agricultural Exports (2018-2024 Average)



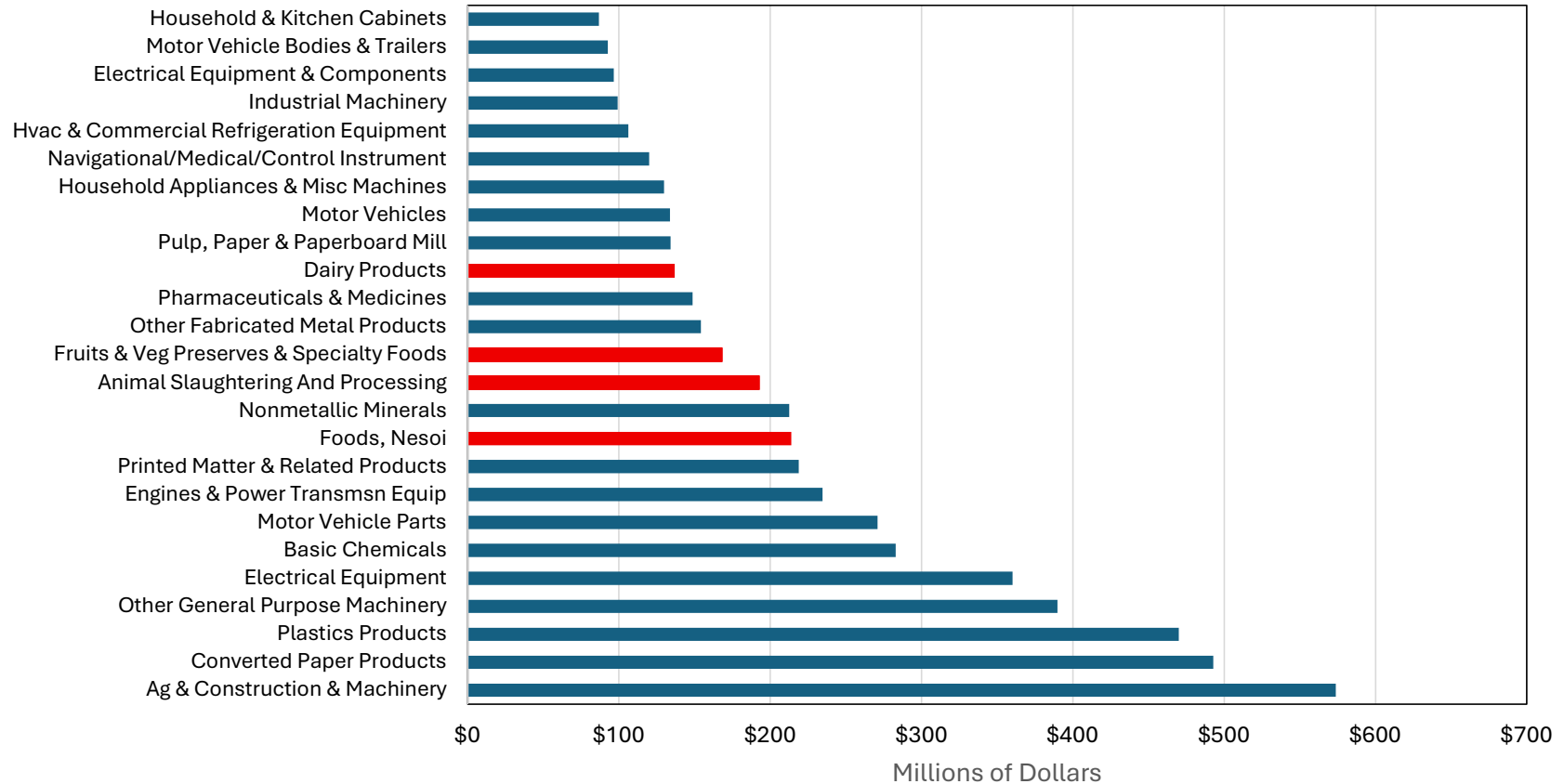

Wisconsin Top 25 Foreign Export Partners (2018 – 2024 Average)



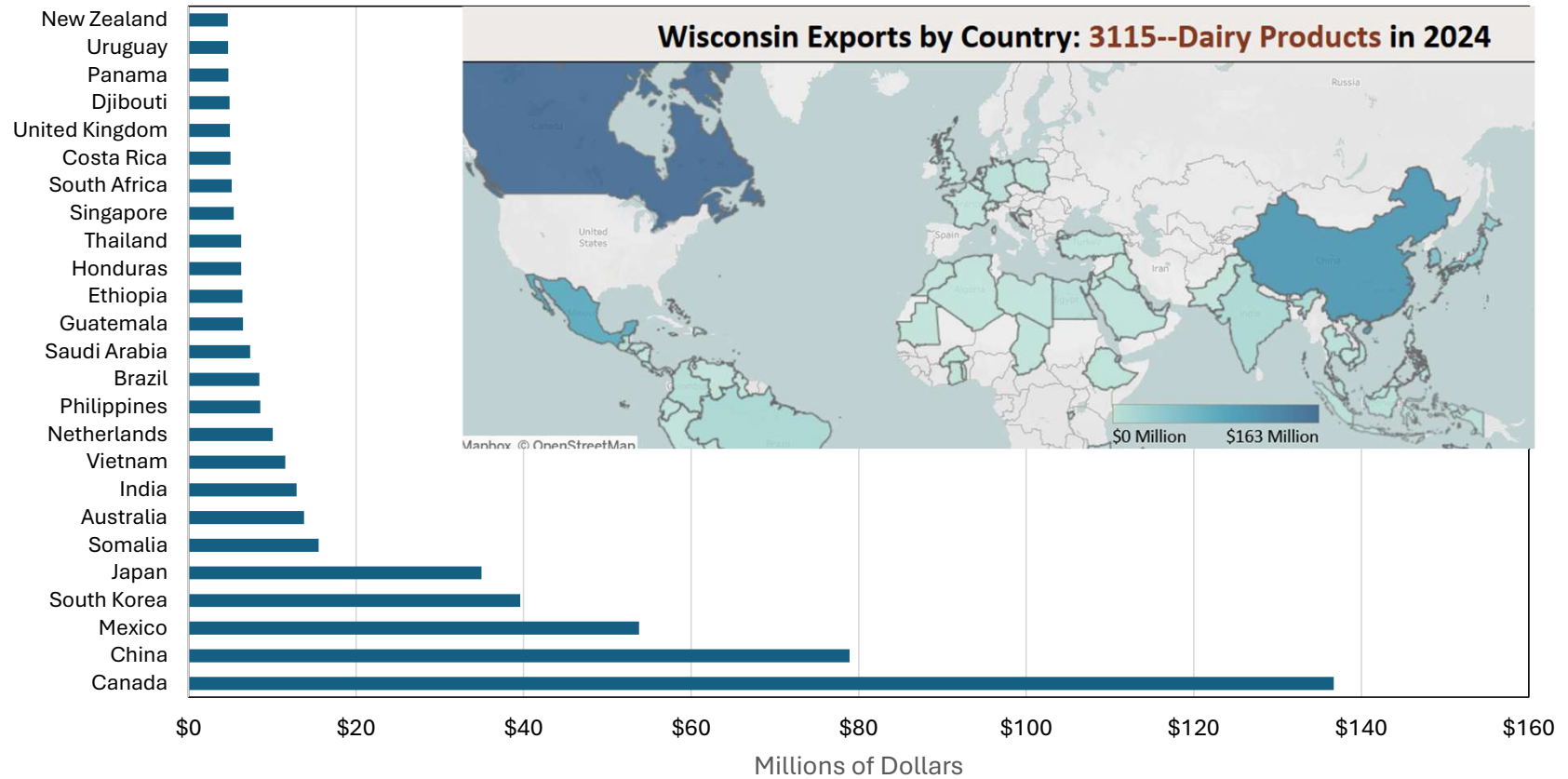

Wisconsin Top 25 **Export To Canada** (2018 – 2024 Average)



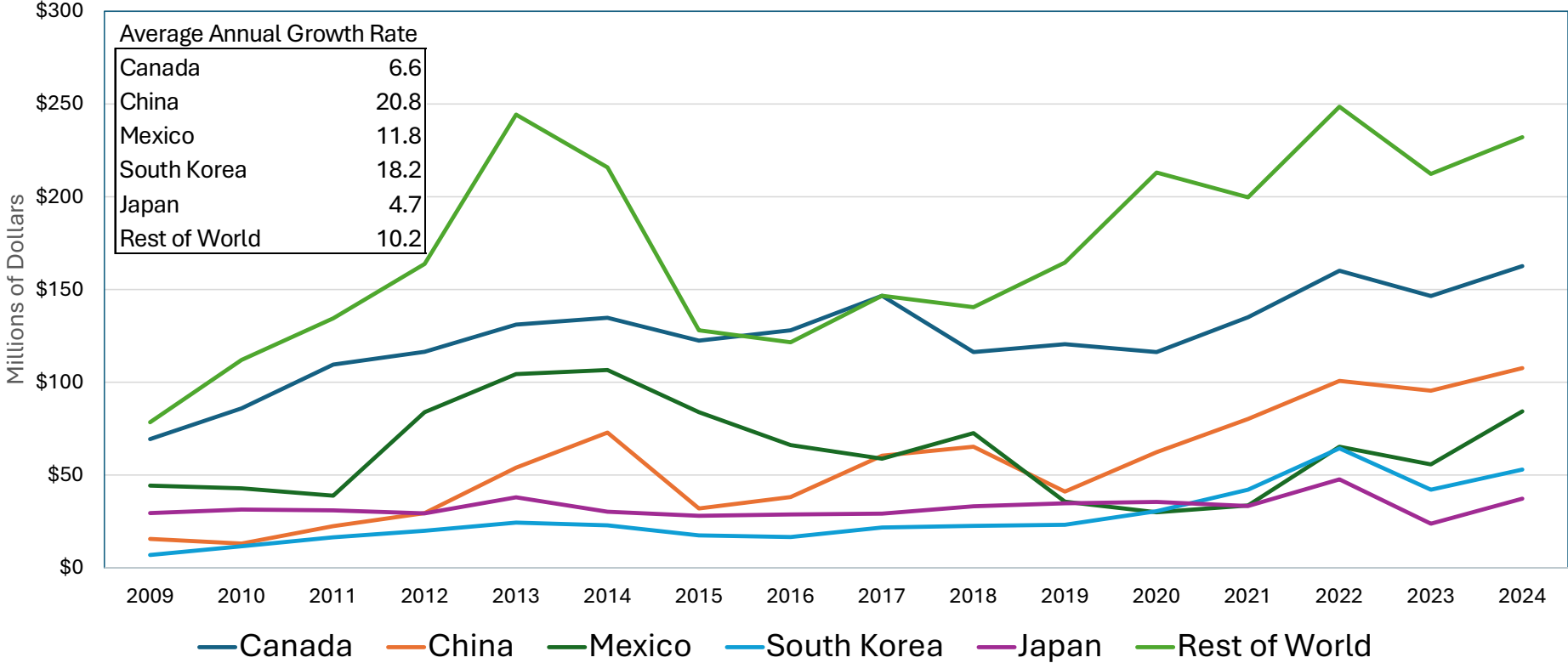

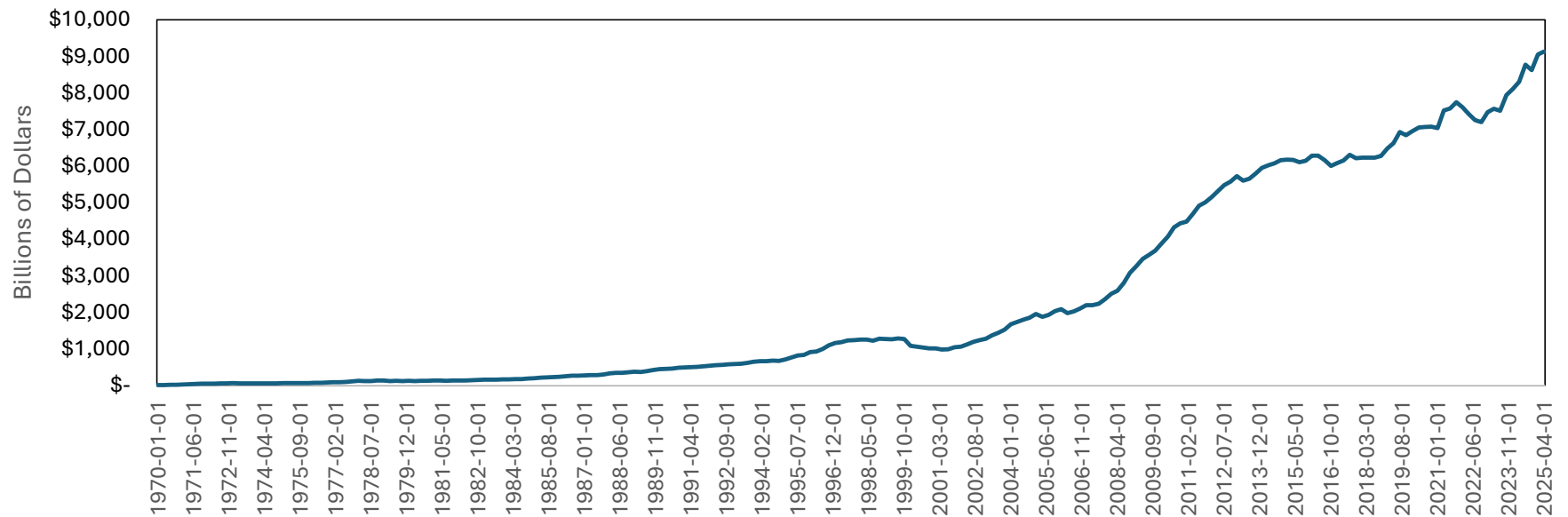
